BUDGET

ADD—Equity is at the heart of what we are trying to do.

- ❖ Math and STEM
 - Add Science Department Head
 - Add STEM teacher – top 10 careers in next ten moves related to science, math, technology
- ❖ NewsELA
 - Same article-comes in 5 Lexile scores
 - Access to all teachers
 - Meets needs of different students
- ❖ Cooking budget
 - More students and inflation
 - Healthy cooking is expensive: produce, milk, butter, meats
- ❖ Guidance Counselor
 - Right now we have 3 and Blanca is a bi-lingual with caseload of 250+450
 - Guidance Counselors are only supposed to have 250 students per ASCA recommendation
 - Another Guidance Counselor would support family engagement
- ❖ Laptop Cart
 - 30 laptops per cart—asking for 6 carts
 - Still won't be enough for one to one but would make one cart per cluster
