To be selected for membership, candidates submit Student Activity Information Sheets with evidence that they meet or exceed these standards. Students are considered for membership during their Junior year. Members participate in volunteer opportunities at school and in the community. Past chapters have participated in the My Brothers Table Walk-a-Thon, served as volunteers at local elementary schools, worked as guides at Classical events, promoted and organized food drives, Soup & Socks Gift of Warmth campaigns and Trick or Treat for Canned Goods activities among others.</p>
