Affidavit of Residence by Landlord, or in Cases of Shared Housing

Any applicant for the Lynn Public Schools **who cannot produce a property deed, lease or a valid proof of address** must ask the owner or lessee of the property where the applicant lives to complete and sign this legal affidavit.

It is the responsibility of the applicant (not the person who completes this affidavit) to attach a record of recent rent payment, unless this affidavit affirms in #3 below that the tenancy does not require payment of rent

Any person who violates or assists in the violation of this provision may be required to remit full restitution to the town of the improperly-attended public schools.
