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Dear Lynn Public Schools Families,

I am writing with an update on plans for the expansion of in-person learning. Last week, you were provided the timeline with specific dates for students to return. Since then, we have been collecting your input and refining our plans. There are two changes to our plans that I hope will be welcomed.

First, a reminder to all families that, in keeping with the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education guidance, any family may choose to remain in remote learning for the remainder of the school year. Students who choose to remain in remote learning will continue to receive live instruction and supports. A choice to remain in remote learning will not impact a student's ability to be promoted to the next grade or graduate from high school. For families who have chosen in-person learning for the remainder of the school year, I would like to share the following updates:

- Kindergarten (AM/PM), 1, and 2 will now begin **five** days of instruction beginning April 5th.
- Grades 3-5 will begin **five** days of instruction beginning April 12th.
- There are no changes to the middle school and high school timeline for expanding in-person learning.

Moving the timeline up to begin five days of in-person learning for all elementary students is something about which we are excited. It is also cause for additional planning and preparation which continues in earnest. You can count on additional communication directly from your student's school. I wanted to get this information to you as quickly as possible to allow you to plan accordingly. For your convenience, I have pasted graphics with a timeline for all schools as well as the hours. As always, please contact your student's school with questions or concerns.
